Roxanne's sisters, bible study group and walking group were all extremely important to her. She also loved the community of Jansen. She spent endless hours volunteering and bettering the community. Last winter, Roxanne was awarded the Queen Jubilee Award for her Lifetime of Volunteerism in Saskatchewan.

Roxanne had a million dollar smile, and shared it with absolutely everyone she met. She will forever be remembered for her empathetic heart, generosity with her time and self-lessness to help those around her. She truly was a blessing to everyone who knew her.
