Thomas Robert Clavelle, aged 68 years, passed away on Wednesday, August 31, 2016.

Thomas Robert (Bob) Clavelle, first born son of the late Walter Benjamin Clavelle and Myrtle Margaret Matilda Clavelle (née Butler) was born on December 28th, 1947 in Saskatoon, Sask.
