Irene Reynolds, aged 86 years, passed away at Lanigan Hospital on Tuesday, March 1, 2016.

Irene was born in the CNR Station in Jasmin, Sask. She lived there with her parents and her four brothers and one sister. She attended Jasmin school and at age 13 moved with her family to Warman where they owned the hotel. She completed Gr. 10 in Warman and finished her high school at Bedford Road Collegiate in Saskatoon. After Gr. 12 she took her RN training at St. Paul's School of Nursing in Saskatoon. Upon graduation in 1951 she took a nursing position in Nokomis where she met and dated Ross. In 1953 to 1954 she nursed in Covina, Calif. Irene returned to Saskatchewan and was a Public Health Nurse based out of Fort Qu'Appelle from 1954 to 1956. She married Ross on March 31, 1956 and had she lived another 30 days, they would have celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary. They lived at their Nokomis farm until they moved to Lanigan in 1970. Irene did bookkeeping for Pound-Maker Feeders in the early '70s and did their Wenonah Farm's books until the early '90s. Together, Ross and Irene loved raising their family, Darryl and Lisa, dancing, travelling to Nevada, Arizona, Alaska, Mexico, Hawaii and most of Canada. Irene loved her pets, ChiChi the Chihuahua and two beagles. Her main organizations were the Order of the Eastern Star and the United Church Women in Nokomis and then Lanigan.

Irene is survived by her loving husband Ross, son Darryl (Janice) of Nokomis, daughter Lisa (Martin) McInnis of Saskatoon; much loved grandchildren, Sydney and Amber of Nokomis and Evan and Kyle of Saskatoon; sisters-in-law Dorothy Evancio and Beth Bell; numerous nieces and nephews.

She was predeceased by her parents; Anton and Katherine Evancio, brothers Mike (Ruth), Steve (Hilda), Jerry, Orest and sister Marion (George) Hope.

Memorial service was held at Knox United Church, Lanigan, Sask. on March 12 conducted by Rev. Rolanda Taylor.
