Heather Jean Kline, age 43, of Central Parkland Lodge in Lanigan passed away peacefully at her residence on Thursday, February 22, 2018 surrounded by her loving family.

Heather was born on July 10, 1974 to Garth and Doris (nee Eichorst) Burns in Humboldt.

She obtained her elementary education at Drake and high school in Lanigan, then went on to attend St. Peter's College for one year. She was active with school activities and her friends. As a family they spent time together, fishing, curling and snowmobiling. Heather was in love with a certain guy from an early age on and was the happiest bride when she married the love of her life Scott Kline on November 6, 1993. They began their married life on a farm near where Scott grew up and they farmed with Scott's dad and brother. They were then blessed with two children, Amy and Bryce. Scott and their children were her life and she was always there for all of them. Heather was a very artistic person and loved to draw and paint from little on and created some beautiful pictures. Heather also enjoyed bowling, music, scrapbooking, playing cards and watching TV. She took part at North Star Mennonite Church by teaching Sunday school and was a leader for "Pioneer Girls" club. Heather was employed at Drake Meats and also as secretary for the Drake Fire Brigade. Heather and Scott enjoyed many snowmobile trips together in various parts of Saskatchewan, B.C. and especially to Island Park, Idaho. She was a "true fisherman", and you could bet that she would catch the most fish in a day and sometimes even the largest; then she could clean them at the end of the day ready for the frying pan. She preferred to be outdoors working in their yard or helping Scott with farming duties. Heather was proud of her ability to grow a good garden and especially some large and tasty strawberries. She also loved the sights and sounds of ducks and geese, and the wild animals like deer and moose that could be seen from their living room window at times. Heather was very supportive of her children, spending time driving them places and was there for them as much as was possible. Her life shattered in 2005 when her only brother, Robby, died in a tragic accident. Heather and Scott, along with Doris and Garth, helped each other through that terrible time. Heather was a very determined, strong-willed young lady who fought a long, hard battle with multiple sclerosis. She fought the process all the way until it overpowered her and took her independence away. She then moved to Central Parkland Lodge for continual care. Heather has left many beautiful pictures that she painted for her family and passed on that talent to her daughter Amy.
