

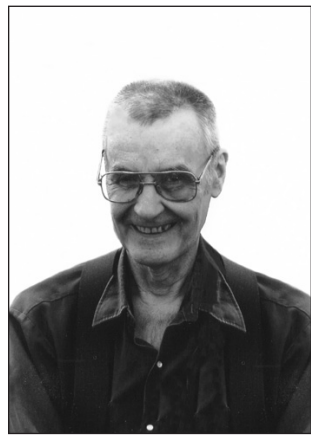

Dwayne Wilfred Cunningham of Lanigan, SK, passed away on Monday, February 19, 2018, at Lanigan Hospital with his family by his side. He was 73 years of age.

Dwayne was born to Wilfred and Antonina "Teenie" (nee Paproski) Cunningham on October 18, 1944 at Humboldt, SK. 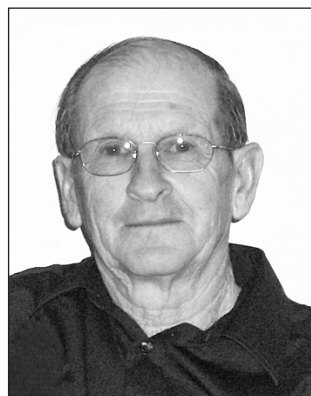
