It is with great sadness that the family of David Earl Miller, 67 years of Jansen, announces his peaceful passing on Friday, October 21, 2016 at Lanigan Hospital.

David was born in Kerrobert, Sask. on February 2, 1949 to Edward and Barbara (nee Weber) Miller. He obtained all of his education in Kerrob-

ert. Upon graduation David started working at the Paper Box Factory in Saskatoon. He then went to Industrial Sales where he worked as a sales, shipper, and warranty clerk for 10 years.
